**1.**

**Subject of License conditions**

Subject of these license conditions are Software products from COMPUS consisting of a copy of the respective computer program in object code or in case of modules for Dynamics AX in source code plus corresponding documentation (in the following called 'COMPUS Software Product'). Documentation consists of electronic or paper based user help and installation documentation. COMPUS Software Products are supplied either in electronic form or on a data carrier. Scope of functionality of COMPUS Software Products is defined in this original documentation. These License conditions do apply to all versions, including full versions, upgrades and updates of COMPUS Software Products.

**2.**

**Copyright and intellectual property right on COMPUS Software Products**

2.1 COMPUS Software Products are protected by copyright, by regulations of international agreements and by other law to protect intellectual property and business confidentiality. COMPUS and its license holders are owner of all rights especially copyrights for all COMPUS Software Products. Infringement of copyright constitutes an essential violation of rights against which COMPUS and its license holders will use all legal possibilities.

2.2 End-user is not allowed to change or to delete any copyright-remarks, serial numbers, marks or hints to trademark rights in the COMPUS Software Products.

2.3 End-user is not allowed to delete any license code that means any codes which does control access to COMPUS Software Products. Nor is end-user allowed to break, to delete, to sidestep or to influence in any way the security mechanisms of COMPUS Software Products.

**3.**

**Scope of Rights for Usage of End-user**

3.1 End-user receives a nonexclusive right to use COMPUS Software Products which are licensed by end-user in accordance of intended use own usage within the company's operation. Own usage within the company's operation means usage of COMPUS Software Products by the employee or external worker of end-user to process data of end-user. Other third parties only may use COMPUS Software Products to the required extend to change data of end-user. End-user is allowed to grant a sublicense to those daughter-companies, where he owns more than 50% of capital or voting rights and where the daughter-company accepts all terms and conditions of the license contract of the end-user. A respective confirmation of the daughter-company has to be provides by the end-user to COMPUS ahead of granting a sublicense. Usage of COMPUS Software Products is restricted to access to database server of end-user only.

End-user is fully responsible for compliance of daughter-company to license conditions.

3.2 COMPUS Software Products must be installed simultaneously only on one and for one database-server (data unit) and may be only used by the number of users/computers (Sessions) for which end-user has acquired the required licenses. COMPUS Software Products must not be installed or copied in a network or any hardware configuration where access of more than the licensed number of

users/computers (Sessions) is possible. If required, end-user can acquire additional licenses to allow simultaneous usage of COMPUS Software Products (in a network or other). Licensed COMPUS Software Products (Product name, Version), licensed number of sessions and the operating system required are tracked in the license file of COMPUS.

3.3 COMPUS Software Products must only be used in an operating system environment released by COMPUS. Otherwise correct functionality of COMPUS Software Product is not ensured.

3.4 End-user is allowed to produce a required number of backup copies of COMPUS Software Products. In each copy case all copyright-remarks, serial numbers, marks or hints to trademark-rights in the COMPUS Software Products must be also copied. Copying of documentation or other material not included in the software is only allowed if authorized in writing by COMPUS. If copies are used as replacement of original version of COMPUS Software Products, these License conditions do apply.

3.5 End-user is not allowed to make any changes on COMPUS Software Products unless authorized by COMPUS in writing.

#### **4. Limitations of Rights of Use**

4.1 In as far as not defined by these license conditions, end-user is not allowed to change, compile, port, reverse engineer, disassemble, decompile or thru other means to establish the source code of COMPUS Software Product unless this is expressly authorized by law.

4.2 End-user is not allowed to fix software bugs by own means as long as COMPUS or third-parties authorized by COMPUS offer this service to competitive conditions.

4.3 If end-user requires additional information beyond supplied documentation to ensure interoperability with other computer programs, end-user will ask COMPUS for support. COMPUS will then decide on supplying the requested information. All regulations with respect to copyright will remain unchanged.

4.4 Leasing of Software Products and granting of sublicenses – in as far as not allowed in this contract – are prohibited.

#### **5. Transfer of COMPUS Software Products**

5.1 End-user is allowed to transfer COMPUS Software Product together with simultaneous transfer usage rights to third parties. COMPUS Software products must only be transferred in total including all parts of it (data carriers, hot fixes, service packs, documentation etc.). Parts of COMPUS Software Products must not be transferred. Third party must accept these license conditions.

5.2 End-user must inform COMPUS about this transfer in writing. With this transfer, third-party acquires all rights of usage of COMPUS Software Product and simultaneously all rights of usage of end user vanishes. End-user is obliged to immediately erase all copies including backup copies of COMPUS Software Products.

5.3 This regulation also applies if transfer of COMPUS Software Product is time limited.

#### **6. Confidentiality and Security Regulation**

End-user has to make sure by reasonable means, that COMPUS Software Products are stored safely and that access of unauthorized people to COMPUS Software Products is prevented. Also end-user has to make sure, that people who have access to COMPUS Software Products do keep to all regulations of these license conditions.

## **7.**

### **Application and Installation; Updates and Upgrades of COMPUS Software Products**

7.1 COMPUS Software Product are Standard programs and COMPUS is not responsible for application environment, usage, supervision of application flow, installation, data control and intended results of COMPUS Software Products.

7.2 COMPUS reserves for COMPUS Software Products the right to change, update and adapt to a changed usage environment. This can lead to the situation, that changed COMPUS Software Product cannot be used in the same Application environment as before. Claims due to this cannot be stated against COMPUS. Updates and upgrades of the standard version of COMPUS Software Products can be acquired by the end customer as soon as they are released by COMPUS to the market.

7.3 COMPUS is not liable for the compatibility of changes of COMPUS Software Product made by the end customer with new updates and upgrades of COMPUS Software Product.

## **8.**

### **Final Conditions**

8.1 These license conditions supersede any license conditions stated electronically or in the documentation of the COMPUS Software Product.

8.2 These license conditions underlay German Law under exclusion of UN-Law on international sales of goods (United Nations Convention on Contracts for the International Sale of Goods, CISG).
